EXECUTIVE BOARD REPORTS

President – Leo Buckon:

We have three new members/visitors present, Mary and Hal Desaussure, and Myra.

The club currently has \$588 in proceeds from the 50/50 raffle, half of which (\$294) will be donated to the Motorcycle Relief Project at the MOA national Rally in Des Moines, Iowa. The Motorcycle Relief Project provides relief to veterans with PTSD symptoms and is also supported by MOA donations.

Leo has researched obtaining club t-shirts and currently has a vendor identified. The current cost will be \$19.95 for one shirt, \$16.95 for 2-10 shirts, and \$14.95 for 11-24 shirts. Stay tuned for additional information as it become available.

Jim Sedivy is coordinating the spring campout at A-1 Twin Valley Campground, 2330 Apollo Rd, Carrollton, Ohio, 44615. The dates are June 29 – July 1, with an estimated cost of \$29 per person plus camping cost. For those not interested in camping there are 3 local hotels to choose from. For anyone who only wants to participate on Saturday without spending the night the cost will be \$17 for food and includes the facility usage fee.

Treasurer - Roger Pivonka advised the club has a total bank balance of \$9,102.00, with a reserve of \$1,750.00, thus an available balance of \$7,352.00. There are currently 180 paid members after 23 were suspended for non-payment.
